STAR TV DTH IN MEXICO TO ADD SATELLITE BROADBAND SERVICE STAR GO

Telecommunications company Star TV (StarGroup) from Mexico announced that it will add a new satellite broadband internet service, which would be branded Star Go, to its DTH operation, confirmed its Director, Jorge Di-Bella, during the Latsat 2016 Satellite Congress.

Star TV, launched as satellite TV operator in January, has the basic Pay-TV package Nova with 50 channels at a monthly price of USD 8.5 besides Supernova pack, with extra 11 signals for USD 11. It operates in the State of Mexico, Coahuila, Tamaulipas, Zacatecas, San Luis Potosi, Jalisco, Veracruz, Hidalgo, Puebla, Tlaxcala and Tabasco.

The company uses the Eutelsat 65 West A satellite, launched by the French company in March to offer both services. Star TV is the adaptation of operator TV Zac, which offered Pay-TV via microwaves in Zacatecas until 2015.
